

#### A Letter from the AzCHA from the Board of Directors to all Members and Friends – December 2015

It's been an exciting and successful 2015 for AzCHA and its members and we are looking forward to more of the same in 2016. Here's a wrap up on 2015 and a look ahead.

#### **2015 Wrap Up**

Once again, we were blessed with great weather, good cattle and fun cutting all year. Perhaps the October show was a little warm (well maybe it was hot?), but the fans, coolers and everyone's positive attitude helped get us all through it. The revised format for the Arizona Futurity was well received by the contestants and resulted in a much larger field in spite of the heat. For the year we had gross revenues of about \$1.8 million and paid out over \$640,000 in prize money. We had approximately 4700 cuts this year. AzCHA again finished the year on very strong financial footing in spite of increased cattle costs.

The final year end standings have been posted on the website. As you know, to win an AzCHA yearend award you must show at AzCHA produced shows at least 30% of the times each class makes. So that everyone is aware of who qualified for and will be presented year end awards, we have posted that list on the home page of the website. Please take a look at this list and let us know if you have any questions.

It was great to see so many AzCHA members in Fort Worth for the 2015 NCHA World Finals and the 2015 NCHA World Championship Futurity. We were very well represented both in the cutting pen and in the stands during the World Finals. We had a very large number of AzCHA members who finished in the Top 15, and a number of World Champions, Reserve World Champions and Show Champions. In the Futurity we were again well represented with semi-finalists and finalists in several classes. The word is out that there is some serious cutting going on in Arizona! Great job and congratulations to all who showed in the World Finals and the Futurity!!!
